


TECHNICAL SERVICE PERSONNEL


When you need a specialist, our Technical Service Personnel can help with services such as Irrigation and Plant Health Care.

SEASONAL SERVICES

FALL CLEANUP

To help prepare your property for winter, we recommend a one-time fall cleanup during the month of October or November. This service removes fallen leaves, leaving your property neat and clean heading into the dormant season. We also offer as-needed services and supplemental leaf removals for properties with a heavy tree canopy.

WINTER CUTBACKS

Some plants need extra care to look their best for multiple seasons. Your Account Manager can advise you on the pruning services your property may need and when they should be performed. These services include cutting back perennials and certain woody ornamentals, and various rejuvenation pruning.

SPRING CLEANUP


After a long winter, spring is a welcome relief. To ensure your property looks its best, our team performs a spring cleanup. During this process, we remove accumulated leaves, sticks and other remnants from turf, beds and tree rings on your property, and prepare it for regular services to commence.


TURF MAINTENANCE

MOWING

Those beautiful stripes in your turf don't just happen. Our team will put together a mowing schedule that considers your property's turf type, irrigation and natural environmental conditions. Typically, we mow every seven days during the growing season, but frequency will be adapted as weather conditions dictate. Mowing services include:

- · Trash and debris removal, before mowing begins
- Neatly edged curbs, walkways and bed line maintenance
- Consistent trim height along fence lines, trees, light poles and other objects
- An emphasis on safety and respect for people and property





FERTILIZATION & PEST CONTROL

Sometimes Mother Nature needs a hand. Applying fertilizers helps stimulate healthy growth and control unwanted weeds, diseases and pests. Your Account Manager can help you design an ideal program for your budget and expectations. A typical turf program has five applications and considers the needs of each season.

1. March

Spring Fertilizer & Pre-Emergent Weed Control Ensures grass turns green and kills weeds.

2. April & May

Fertilizer plus Broadleaf Weed Control

Maintains grass color and controls weeds into summer.

3. June & July

Supplemental Fertilizer
Sustains turf vigor and includes optional grub control treatment.

4. August & September

Fertilizer plus Broadleaf Weed Control
Maintains grass color and weed control into fall.

5. October & November

Fertilizer

Winterizes grass to promote strong roots and health into spring.



AERATION & OVERSEEDING

Rainfall, root growth and traffic can compact the soil over time. Our aeration service, performed from mid-August to late September, opens up the soil to air, nutrients and moisture and encourages healthy growth come spring. Aeration is often paired with overseeding to maintain summer grass color into the cooler months. Your Account Manager can recommend the ideal treatment for your property and budget.

INSECT & DISEASE CONTROL

Pests and disease can wreak havoc on a landscape. Our weekly inspections allow our team to identify these types of issues while they are small ones. If a problem is discovered, we'll promptly inform you and suggest proper action to fix it.

MULCH & WEED CONTROL

MULCHING

Fresh mulch not only makes your property look its best—it also supports the health of your landscape by improving the soil's ability to retain moisture and acting as a barrier to control weeds. We spread an even application of double-ground dyed hardwood mulch each spring. In addition, we provide trenching of plant bed lines and tree rings to contain the mulch, and cleanup services after application.

PLANT BED WEED CONTROL

The best time to control weeds is before they appear. We apply our pre-emergent weed control service during the mulching process to kill weeds as they germinate from seeds. Larger weeds or those that escape treatment are controlled through targeted spraying or hand removal.

PAVEMENT WEED CONTROL

Our crews are always on the lookout for weeds, even in pavement and hardscape areas. We use chemical treatment to control these types of weeds when they first sprout and to inhibit regrowth.



SHRUB, GROUND COVER & TREE CARE

PRUNING

Every landscape is different, and our expert team understands that many plants have unique growth habits and trimming needs. Your Account Manager can recommend a customized schedule for your property that includes occasional pruning of shrubs to preserve their form and function, thinning of plants to remove dead and damaged wood, and trimming or sizing to maintain your desired look.

EDGING

Ground cover provides a distinguished look to your landscape. Your Account Manager will help you ensure it maintains a fresh and even appearance by recommending edging and trimming services, so it stays within the desired bounds.

TRIMMING

Trees require special attention to detail. Our team will trim trees under 15 feet, located within turf and landscape beds or along sidewalk areas, to ensure healthy development. If your property contains taller trees, we will prune low-hanging branches up to 12 feet to prevent encroachmen into pedestrian areas.



IRRIGATION SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

SPRING START-UP

Winter can be hard on irrigation systems. During our spring start-up service, we restore the water flow to your system and inspect it from end-to end for proper water flow and pressure. This process identifies any valve or line leaks and locates any broken heads that need to be replaced or adjusted for proper coverage. We can also program your irrigation controller.

WET CHECKS

Your Account Manager will schedule irrigation service visits (known as "wet checks") throughout the growing season, according to your property's needs. During these visits we check each zone for proper water flow and pressure, monitor for leaks, identify needed repairs and adjust sprinkler heads for proper water coverage. In addition, backflow inspections are available by request.

CONTROLLER ADJUSTMENTS

To maintain proper soil moisture for your property, our team will make periodic adjustments to watering intervals and zone durations based on environmental conditions.

WINTERIZATION

Sitting water and freezing temperatures do not mix. Our team will prepare your irrigation lines for winter, clearing them with compressed air and shutting off the controller and water source during the winter season.

REPAIRS

Time, physical damage and the constant effects of flowing water wear out irrigation system parts. During wet checks and other inspections, we will continually monitor your system. If repairs are needed, we will alert you to any costs that fall outside your service agreement and will make necessary repairs upon approval.


BED PREPARATION
